Dear Parents/Carers

As I suspected within the last twenty-four hours we have had new guidance from the government, the earliest we expect children to return to school is 22nd February 2021.

From tomorrow, Wednesday 6th January 2021, infant children and Nursery will enter school through their usual classroom doors, Nursery to arrive at 8:30am and infants at 8:45am. Juniors will enter the school hall through the Fire Doors at 9:00am, where they will be separated into their bubbles before heading to their classrooms. Pick up times for infants will be 3:00pm from their classroom doors, junior children pick up time will be 3:15pm from the School Hall Fire Doors. Please note Nursery is open to **all children**.

Lunches will continue to be hot dinners but the published menu will not be followed. If you would like your child to have a hot dinner, please ring the school office before 10:00am. If your child is eligible for a means tested free school meal (benefit related), and you require a packed lunch to be collected from the school office at 12 noon, again please ring the school office before 10:00am to order them.

Teachers have been busy preparing additional learning support materials. These are to be used in conjunction with work set on Purple Mash. Parents wishing to collect the hard copy home learning materials can do so from 2:00pm tomorrow from the main office, please bring previously issued folder or simply a plastic bag for these materials. Teachers will be contacting families directly through Purple Mash shortly.

Please ensure Key Worker children only attend school when absolutely necessary as we are not fully staffed due to Covid-19.

Sports Coaches are not allowed into schools, and therefore, after school clubs will not take place this half term.

For parents of children who are not in school, we have been advised by Public Health Oldham to inform parents the importance of notifying school if any of their family develop symptoms or have a positive test result this week, they need to inform school immediately. For parents who have been identified as key workers or have vulnerable children in school, they need to carry on informing school as they have been doing so, going forward.

This guidance is current today, Tuesday 5th January 2021. I will inform you of any further changes.
