Dear Parents/carers,

Welcome back after the Easter holiday! We hope you and your children have had a lovely time. As we begin the Summer Term, we would like to share with you some of the work that we have planned to cover with the Year 2 children.

Literacy

Our Literacy lessons this term will cover a range of different genres. There will be a wide coverage of both fiction and non-fiction units and the children will complete an assessed 'Big Write' at the end of each unit. This term we will be writing Quatrain poems, fairy stories, adverts, diaries, information texts and adventure stories. The children will also be taking part in whole class reading sessions each day and handwriting and spelling patterns will also be taught daily. We will continue to have a spelling test each week on Fridays. Our class novels for this term will be 'The Creakers' by Tom Fletcher.

Maths

Number work in our maths lessons will continue to ensure that children have a good understanding of the number system. We will focus Fractions, Time, Statistics, Position and Direction.

Topic

Our first topic for this term will be 'What does the seaside look like around the world?' This will be a Geography topic. Our second topic will be linked to the local area and history. The topic question will be 'What was life like when Greenfield Primary School first opened and how might it change in the future?'

Science

Science will be taught each week and this term we will continue our topic about plants (bulbs and seeds) before moving onto human growth.

Things to remember

PE lessons are planned to be twice weekly:

Year 2 Maple- Mrs Snape- Tuesdays and Thursdays

Year 2 Juniper – Miss Cassinelli- Mondays and Fridays

Please ensure that all items in the PE kit are clearly labelled. Towards the end of last term we had a lot of children who frequently did not wear a PE kit in school for PE lessons. Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct school PE kit for all days they have PE lessons. Children are encouraged to have a water bottle in school. Please ensure your child's bottle has their name on it.

Reading books will continue to be changed as children return them to school during the week and then sent home on Friday. New spellings will be set on Spelling Shed each Friday for a spelling test the following Friday. Please also encourage your child to use the mastery section on Spelling Shed as often as possible. Purple homework writing books will continue to be sent home every Friday. Children should write three sentences using some of the spellings for that week. Children should be encouraged to form letters correctly and neatly and remember full stops, capital letters and finger spaces. On Times Table Rock Stars there are some 2, 5 and 10 times tables to practise. As the term continues we will also be learning the 3 times table and corresponding division facts.

This year there are no statutory end of KS1 assessments to complete (KS1 SATS). We will be completing assessments (showing off jobs) later in the summer term but these will be used for our own 'in school' tracking purposes.

We currently have two final placement students from Manchester Metropolitan University working with us in Maple and Juniper Class. Miss Ali and Miss Rahman will be with us until the end of June. We hope that this information is useful however please do not hesitate to speak with us if you have any further questions. We are available from 8am most mornings before school or alternatively you can speak to us at the classroom door at the end of the school day.
