Dear Parents/Carers

We hope you all had a fantastic Easter break and everyone is rested and ready for the Summer term.

Maths

This term in Maths we will be mainly focusing on measurement such as time, shape, money and position. We will be also taking part in the national times table assessment – where pupils will answer 24 random times table questions. We will be continuing to practise in class.

Support at home:

Being able to tell the time both with an analogy clock and 24 hours will help support their learning this term. **Times tables!** Learning their times tables will help pupils' maths skill going forward especially as they progress in KS2. The only way to improve is practise, through games and TTRS. If you or your child needs any support in this area, please speak to us.

English

Our class novel will be '**Friend or Foe**' which will link to our history unit on World War 2. Spellings will continue to be set weekly on Spelling Shed. I also want children to play on 'Mastery Zone' where spellings are personalised to suit each individual.

Reading is so important! We ask that your child read at **least 3 times a week at home**, this needs to be recorded in their reading record by parent or the child. Their reading record and book needs to be returned once a week, so we can monitor the children's progress, support any issues and change books.

Topic

Our History topic this half term will be '**How did World War Two affect the people of Britain?**' As part of this topic we are hoping to visit Stockport air raid shelter to gain hands on experience about life in World War Two.

The second half term the question we will be looking at is '**Which way do we go?**' where pupils will be doing orienteering, compass, and map work. We will be spending a lot of this time outside looking at the context of where we live.

Science

This term in Science we will be looking at Living things and their habitats where we are hoping to go do lots of outdoor learning; in addition to digestive systems and food chains.
