Dear Parents/Carers

I hope that you have all had a lovely Easter and are ready for the Summer term! Below I have summarised the subject areas your child will be covering throughout the Summer Term and other key information.

Maths:

This term we will be covering multiplication, division, fractions, position and direction, place value within 100, money, time and problem solving.

English:

During the Summer term we will continue to write for a range of purposes including postcards, instructions and information posters. In addition to English lessons children will be taking part in daily phonics sessions where they will consolidate their knowledge of previously learnt sounds and tricky words as well as learning new ones. Children will also be practicing their handwriting each day.

Science:

In our weekly Science lessons this term, we will be covering plants, growing and cooking and seasonal changes.

Geography:

In the Summer Term we will be focusing on the questions 'Where do the wheels on the bus go?' and 'What do you know about Great Britain?'

Other Subjects:

Your child will have a computing session every week. Within these sessions, they will develop their knowledge of ICT and will become more confident using different programs. This term will focus on digital writing. RE lessons will centre around the questions 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?' and 'What can we learn from sacred books and stories?' Children will also take part in weekly Art or DT, music and PSHE lessons.

PE:

PE sessions will continue to take place every Monday so please send your child to school in their PE kit every Monday.

General Information:

Children will need shoes with velcro or buckle fastenings so that they can put their shoes on independently and limit the risk of tripping over untied laces. Please ensure your child comes to school with a coat and a water bottle every day. Please make sure items from home (such as toys) are not brought into school. This is to avoid distraction and disruption during learning time. However, we are more than happy for children to share any special achievements such as certificates, awards or special news.

Homework:

Spellings will continue to be set on a Friday and reading books should continue to be brought to school daily. To consolidate your child's maths learning at home please complete activities on the app 'White Rose 1-Minute Maths.'

As always we are on-hand daily if you wish to discuss any of the information included in this letter further. We look forward to the term ahead!
