Dear Parents/Carers,

We hope that you have had a lovely Christmas break and would like to wish you all a happy new year! Below is a summary of the subject areas your child will be covering throughout the Spring Term and other key information.

Maths:

This term we will be covering addition and subtraction within 20, place value within 50, length and height, mass and volume and word problems.

English:

During the Spring term we will be learning to write for a range of purposes including writing directions, letters, fact sheets and narratives. In addition to English lessons children will be taking part in daily phonics sessions where they will consolidate their knowledge of previously learnt sounds and tricky words as well as learning new ones. Children will also be practicing their handwriting each day.

Topic:

The first half term's topic will centre around the question 'What are the seasonal changes in the UK?' and for the second half term we will be answering the question 'What can we discover around our school?'

Science:

Our science units for Spring are:

- Animals including Humans
- Caring for the Planet
- Seasonal Change
- Planting

Other Subjects:

Your child will have a computing session every week. Within these sessions, they will develop their knowledge of ICT and will become more confident using different programs. This term we are learning how to program a robot.

RE lessons will be centred around the question 'What do Muslims believe and how do they live?' Children will also take part in weekly Art or DT, music and PSHE lessons.

PE:

PE sessions will continue to take place every Monday so please send your child to school in their PE kit every Monday.

General Information:

Children will need shoes with velcro or buckle fastenings so that they can put their shoes on independently and limit the risk of tripping over untied laces.

Please ensure your child comes to school with a coat and a water bottle every day.

Please make sure items from home (such as toys) are not brought into school. This is to avoid distraction and disruption during learning time. However, we are more than happy for children to share any special achievements such as certificates, awards or special news.

Homework:

Spellings will continue to be set on a Friday and reading books should continue to be brought to school daily. To consolidate your child's maths learning at home please download an app called White Rose 1-Minute Maths and encourage your child to spend some time practising their skills within the 'subitising,' 'addition' and 'subtraction' areas.

As always we are on-hand daily if you wish to discuss any of the information included in this letter further.
