- runs west from Lancaster Sound.

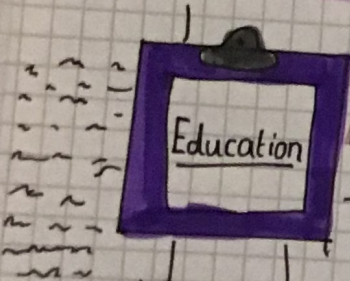


• He had a brother named Charles Henry Parry

He was an artic explorer

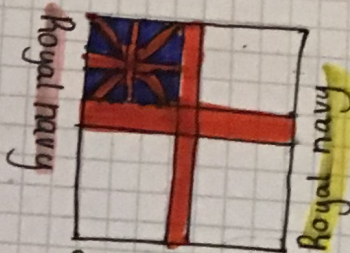
In April 1829 he was knighted
