PE

Reading Books

Children are going to bring home a reading book and their reading record each week. Could you please continue to read with your child at home and add a comment to their reading record. I will continue to provide children with extra books via E-Collins if children would like to read additional books at home. Feel free to add book names/comments (from E-Collins) into your child's reading record.

Homework

I will continue to set homework on Purple Mash each week. All children are expected to have a go at completing the work set on Purple Mash. The majority of homework should provide most children with the opportunity to complete the task independently. The homework that I set is usually a recap of something that has been taught previously.

Hot weather

Could you please ensure that children have had sun cream applied before they come to school when we are expecting hot weather. The children spend time outdoors at both break time and lunchtime and therefore it is important that children are well protected from the sun. A sun hat and a water bottle may also be a good idea for children to bring into school each day.

Snack and water bottles

May I politely remind you that children are asked to bring a healthy snack into school (if they wish) and water in their water bottles. Children are provided with a bottle of milk and a piece of fruit each day, however I know that some children do like to bring their own fruit. I have spoken to Pine class as part of a circle time activity to talk about the importance of this. All children discussed their favourite fruit and participated in our class discussion. Children explained their understanding as to why we would like healthy snacks and water in school as opposed to juice or other items of food that isn't fruit. I will continue to remind children of the importance of this. Once again, thank you for your support with this.
