Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to extend a very warm welcome to all our new children joining us in Nursery this term. Welcome back to all the children who are continuing their learning with us. This is your termly newsletter, where we send any necessary information, reminders and updates about what is going on in Nursery.

Over the next few weeks, we will be enjoying getting to know the children alongside the learning theme 'Marvellous Me'. This theme will provide opportunities for the children and staff to look closely and compare their features and create some self-portraits and crafts relating to this theme. We will also be learning about a different colour each week, with many areas in the classroom enhanced with the colour of the week.

We will be sending your child's crafts home in a plastic school bag. We ask that parents empty the bag and return it to school as soon as possible so that we can keep organised. Our children like to be very creative, and so, we tend to have lots of things to send home every few days.

Please make sure all of your child's clothing is labelled, including coats and water bottles. Jumpers and cardigans are taken off on a daily basis, and if they are not labelled, they are easily mixed up. Your child should also have a water bottle labelled with their name to be kept in school.

Please make sure you send your child to Nursery in a coat every day which is suitable for outdoor play. Your child will also need a change of clothes in a labelled bag to be kept on their peg in case of accidents.

Children who are in nappies also need to be brought to Nursery each day with enough nappies, wipes and nappy sacks.

If your child has a school dinner, these are an additional cost of £2.70 per day. Nursery fees must be paid separately to school dinners, as they are processed separately.

If you have been given a Parent Declaration form which you are yet to complete and return, please may I ask you do so as soon as possible, as our School Business Manager will soon be processing them so that school can receive funding. A delay in returning these forms could mean we miss deadlines for funding for your child. These forms need completing on a termly basis if you are eligible for funding for your child's Nursery place.

If you wish to extend your child's hours at Nursery, we have currently got some spaces available. A few parents discussed wanting to increase hours for their child termly through the year. This is something we can accommodate, subject to availability, so please give me a call at school if you wish to discuss this option.

If you plan to take your child out of school during term time, please put this in writing for the attention of Mr Wood, head teacher. This allows us to update our registers accordingly.

I wish to reassure you that although circumstances have meant I have not been teaching in Nursery in the initial days of the new term, I am still very much involved with the staff team, with daily conversations around how the children are settling in and input into planning. As always, if you have any concerns or questions in the coming weeks, please do not hesitate to contact me, or speak to any member of the Nursery team.
