Dear Parents/Carers

We are well into the spring term now and I am delighted that our new children have settled in so well. Welcome to our new children and families. We usually send out a Nursery Newsletter once a term to keep you informed of upcoming events and themes we plan to cover with the children.

Since starting back after the holidays the children have been exploring the theme of winter and we have discovered lots of new information about penguins and polar bears. We have also spent some time finding out about Chinese New Year.

As we follow the children's interests, we are yet to decide what the next theme we cover will be, so watch this space!

Your child will have been sent home with a plastic school bag. We send these home full of all the lovely pictures and crafts we have been busy creating. It is important that we get these bags back a.s.a.p. as they help us keep organised!

We have a shortage of spare clothes at the moment. Every child should have a spare change of clothes in a labelled bag on their peg in case of accidents. If your child is sent home in Nursery spare clothes, please wash and return them promptly so that they can be used again. Also, if you have any spare leggings, socks or jogging pants that your child has grown out of and you are planning to give them to charity, please keep us in mind.

Some parents have been asking about whether their child is allowed to bring in toys from home. Some children have comfort toys which help them to settle at Nursery and so we do not stop children from bringing in toys from home. However, we do discourage children from bringing in jewellery and small toys or toys with small parts that could be easily lost or pose a potential choking hazard.

Please could you ensure any money for school dinners and fees is paid in on the first day your child attends Nursery each week. Please put fees and money for dinners into separate envelopes. School dinners cost £2.30 per day.

For those parents who returned the permission slip for a parent access to their child's Tapestry online learning journal, we are in the process of setting up your parent accounts. This should be up and running shortly. We will inform you of next steps in activating your parent access to allow you to view our observations of your child at Nursery. If you have not yet given permission for us to create a Tapestry login for you as a parent/carer, please ask for another copy of the letter.

We have a 48-hour policy for sickness and diarrhoea so if your child is sent home from Nursery poorly with these symptoms or has an upset stomach at home, it is important you keep them at home for 48 hours after the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. This policy is in place to avoid the spread of such illness. If your child is poorly, please give school a call on 0161 770 5525 to let us know why your child is absent.

As usual, we have an open door policy and are always happy to help with any of your concerns or questions, so please ask if you are unsure of anything.
