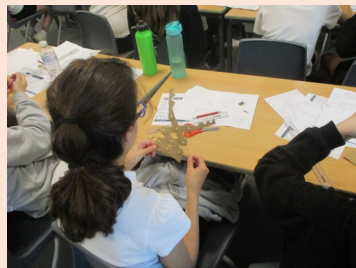

Voluntary One-Way System
