Dear Parents/Carers

On Friday 7th May school will be taking part in the NSPCC Number Day. This day is designed not only to promote number in schools but also to spread awareness of the NSPCC and the role they play in society today. As part of the day children will take part in a variety of activities linked to number. These may include games and activities such as counting, songs, treasure hunts, playing cards or dominoes or timed sporting activities such as how many star jumps can we do in 30 seconds?

We will also be taking part in another event run by Times Table Rock Stars to support Number Day called NSPCC Rocks. Here classes will compete to see which class can answer the most times tables questions correctly on Friday 7th May between the hours of 8:00am and 8:00pm so we hope you can support us at home by joining in there too. The NSPCC are also supporting the 'Captain Tom 100 Challenge' which ties in nicely with Number Day. This challenge will take place nationally this bank holiday weekend but we will challenge all the children across school to complete a 100 challenge in different ways during Number Day.

We would also like to invite children to come to school dressed as something number related, this could be something creative such as a dice, playing cards or dominoes costumes or you could keep it simple with clothing which contains a number such as a football shirt.

After Friday's Number Day, each class will be covering a variety of sessions related to safeguarding children. These will include keeping children safe online, using the unit of work 'keeping myself safe' from our school's PSHE scheme SCARF, watching videos sent to school regarding safety near railways and water and using the PANTS resources from the NSPCC.
