Dear Parents/Carers

Just a little reminder that the infant sports days that will take place next week are on the school field located on Shaw Street. The following events are all weather permitting and if for any reason there is a cancellation, the school office will inform you via a parent mail message the morning of your child's event:

- EYFS Sports Days will both take place on **Monday 10th July** but will be split separately. Nursery's event will begin at **9.30am** and Reception's will begin at **1.30pm.**
- Key Stage 1 Sports Day (Years 1, 2 and 2/3) will be taking place on **Tuesday 11th July at 1.30pm.**
- Key Stage 2 Sports Day (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) will be taking place on **Wednesday 12th July at 1.30pm.**

All events will be held on the school field located on Shaw Street and family members and friends wishing to watch the event should ensure to be on the school field 15 minutes before the events begin. This will help to ensure that staff members can safely walk children from their classrooms onto the school field with minimal disruptions and distractions when walking along the pavement and crossing the road. All children will have an allocated place to sit during the event and we ask that parents/carers do not approach their children at any point during the event. We understand that younger siblings may wish to see an older brother or sister; however, we ask that siblings are kept within the spectators' area on the opposite side of the field with chairs. Again, this is to ensure that the event can run smoothly without any disruptions.

Due to limited seating, if possible, it would be really helpful if adults could bring a camping chair. Children must wear the correct school P.E kit and trainers to school on the day. Unfortunately, children will not be able to participate in sports day if they do not have their P.E kit and suitable footwear due to ensuring the health and safety of your child. Your child will need to bring a sun hat, a plastic water bottle and sun cream (weather dependent) into school on the day of their event. It is an open field and therefore should the sun be shining; it is extremely important that they are protected from the sun and are kept well hydrated.

Both staff and children are looking forward to the sports day events and we hope that you are able to join us in what we hope will be very exciting and fun filled events. Once the event has finished, we ask that you remain in the spectators' area until all children have left the school field and are back at school. There will be a large number of children on both days returning to school and therefore it is much easier for staff if parents/carers do not add to the large numbers by approaching their child. I am positive that you will assist us and help to ensure minimal disruption by staying within the allocated area for spectators.
