Dear Parents /Carers

It is a requirement to review your school's Behaviour Policy annually.

The key changes this year are that we will no longer be using the 'Good to be Green' system and therefore will not be issuing Red or Yellow cards. We will however, still be using the same principles of ensuring any child whose behaviour is impacting on their own or others' learning or who is not behaving in a safe way will be expected to attend a reflection session with a member of staff to discuss and reflect upon their behaviour and how they can improve it in the future. The forms completed during these sessions will be sent home with a reminder of the School's Rules and we ask that parents sign and return the form to school the following day and discuss their child's behaviour with them at home.

We are continuing with the 'Stamps and Badges' system to reward children for their hard work and good behaviour. Unfortunately, over the past year, we saw very few children wearing the badges that they had earned. In order to promote more pride in their badges and to encourage children to wear any badges they are awarded on a daily basis, we will be asking the children for ideas on privileges they can access when they wear their badges. These could range from a disco at break time to a weekly hot chocolate and biscuit (we're sure the children will have lots of suggestions). Your child will only be able to access these privileges if they are wearing their badges. If your child loses their badge, then replacement ones can be bought at the school office for 50p (coloured badges) or £1 for the silver and gold badges.

We will also be continuing with our weekly Celebration Assembly where we acknowledge and celebrate the progress, hard work and achievements of many children in each class each week. It would be lovely if any children who achieve something really special outside of school brought in their certificates, trophies and medals so that we can share their successes with the rest of the school.

A copy of the School Rules has also been sent home for you to discuss with your child. We are very proud of the behaviour the majority of the school children at our school show on a daily basis. It is often commented on from people who visit our school or when we take our children out on trips / events. We know the impact good behaviour has on the quality of education your child receives and how safe they feel whilst they are with us. Please continue to support us in setting and maintaining these high expectations of our children so that we can all come to school and reach our full potential in a safe and respectful environment.
