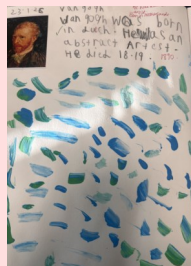


School Building & Site Update:

Since our school building was completed in 2019, we have been managing a small number of ongoing site-related issues, including drainage in parts of the playground/pathways, overheating in some areas during summer months and occasional roof leaks.
