Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Year 4 – we hope you had a lovely winter break and are ready to settle into the new term ahead.

Maths

This term in maths we will be covering multiplication and division, length and perimeter, fractions and decimals. We are continuing practicing our times tables in preparation for the Multiplication Table Check. Please make sure your child practices on TT Rockstars regularly.

English

Our class novels will be *Who Let the Gods Out* by Maz Evans and *Harry Potter and the Philosophers Stone* by J K Rowling. We are focusing on different spelling rules and prioritising improving spelling. Handwriting remains a priority, and we will be practising it each week. Some children have already started using a handwriting pen. We are focusing on our inference skills in reading.

Reading is so important!

We ask that your child reads at least three times a week at home. This needs to be recorded in their reading record by either a parent or the child. The reading record and book must be returned once a week so we can monitor progress, support any issues, and change books where needed.

Topic

Our geography focus is on settlements: “*Are all settlements the same?*”

We will be looking at where settlements are located, names of settlements and what early settlers needed.

Science

This term in science we will learn about sound and how it travels, and electricity.

PE

Please ensure children come to school in their PE kits. Their kit should consist of a white polo shirt, black shorts, and, for outdoor PE, black jogging bottoms or a black tracksuit with black trainers. PE is timetabled for Monday and Friday.

Music

Our cornet lessons will continue for the rest of this year. We are becoming fantastic musicians!

Homework

- Written homework in your child’s homework book.
- Read at least three times a week.
- Online practice: Spelling Shed and Times Table Rock Stars.

Dojos will be awarded to pupils who complete their homework.

We are looking forward to a fantastic term and can’t wait to celebrate your children in our class assembly.
