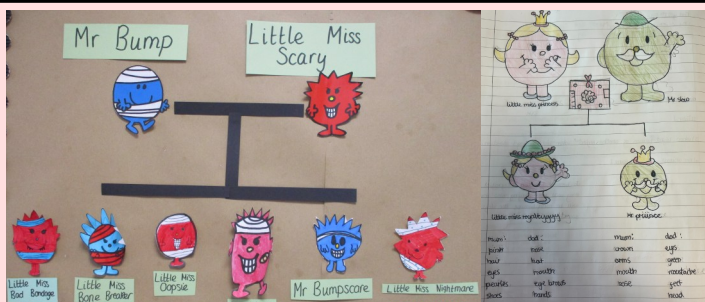


## This week's news

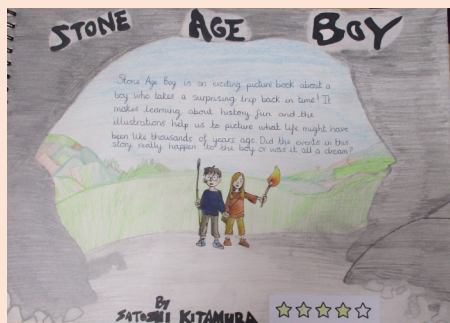


## More News
